DIRECTIONS (the bridge on Gobles Rd is closed)

- **From Toronto:** Hwy 401 to Oxford Rd 29 (exit 250). Left over 401, right on Gobles Rd (first road). Right on Twp Rd 3, 1st farm on right.
- **From London:** Hwy 401 to County Rd 2 East (Exit 238). Oxford Rd 2 to Cty Rd 22, turn left on 22 to Twp Rd 3, turn right, last farm on left before stop sign.
- **From Hamilton/Niagara:** Hwy 403 to Brant Rd 25, north (right) on Brant Rd 25 to Oxford Rd 2 (stop sign). Left on Rd 2 to 1st road on right (into Princeton) to Twp Rd 2, turn left to Stop sign at Gobles Rd, turn right, then left on Twp Rd 3, 1st farm on right.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Dogs may enter both the Instinct Test and Novice class in the same trial *until the dog has earned the RATN title and then they cannot enter the Instinct Test.*

Dogs completing the RATN in the one trial may be moved up to Open for the next trial. This is up to the handler and not required.

Move-ups will be accepted up until ½ hour after the conclusion of Trial 1.

Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's table.

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50 fee for all returned checks.

Dogs must have a Barn Hunt registration number.

Bitches in season may compete, but must wear panties, and will run last.

Please inform the trial secretary, as well as the judge.

Dogs will be staged in groups of 5, dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.

Barn Hunt is fairly worker intensive! Please plan to help as course builders, scribe, gatekeeper. Sign up sheets will be available.

Volunteers are always welcome, and we will have a workers raffle!
